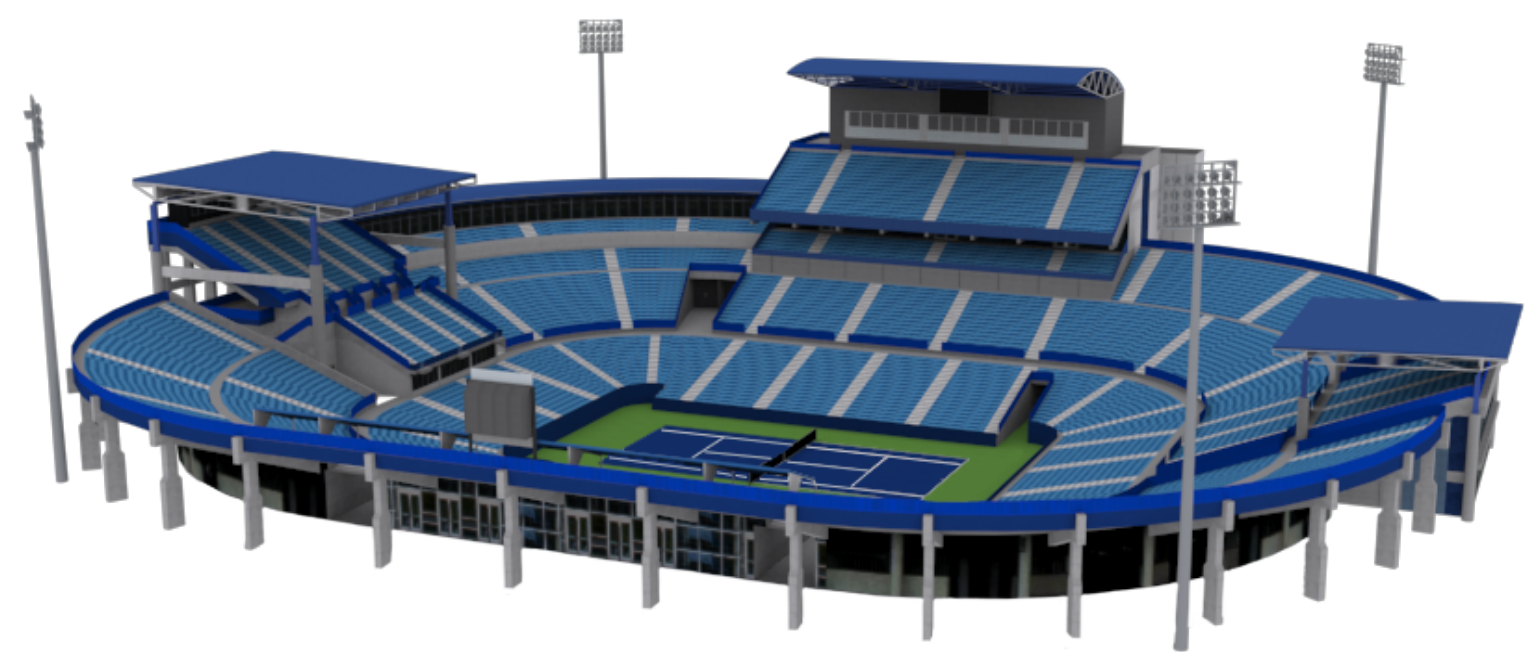

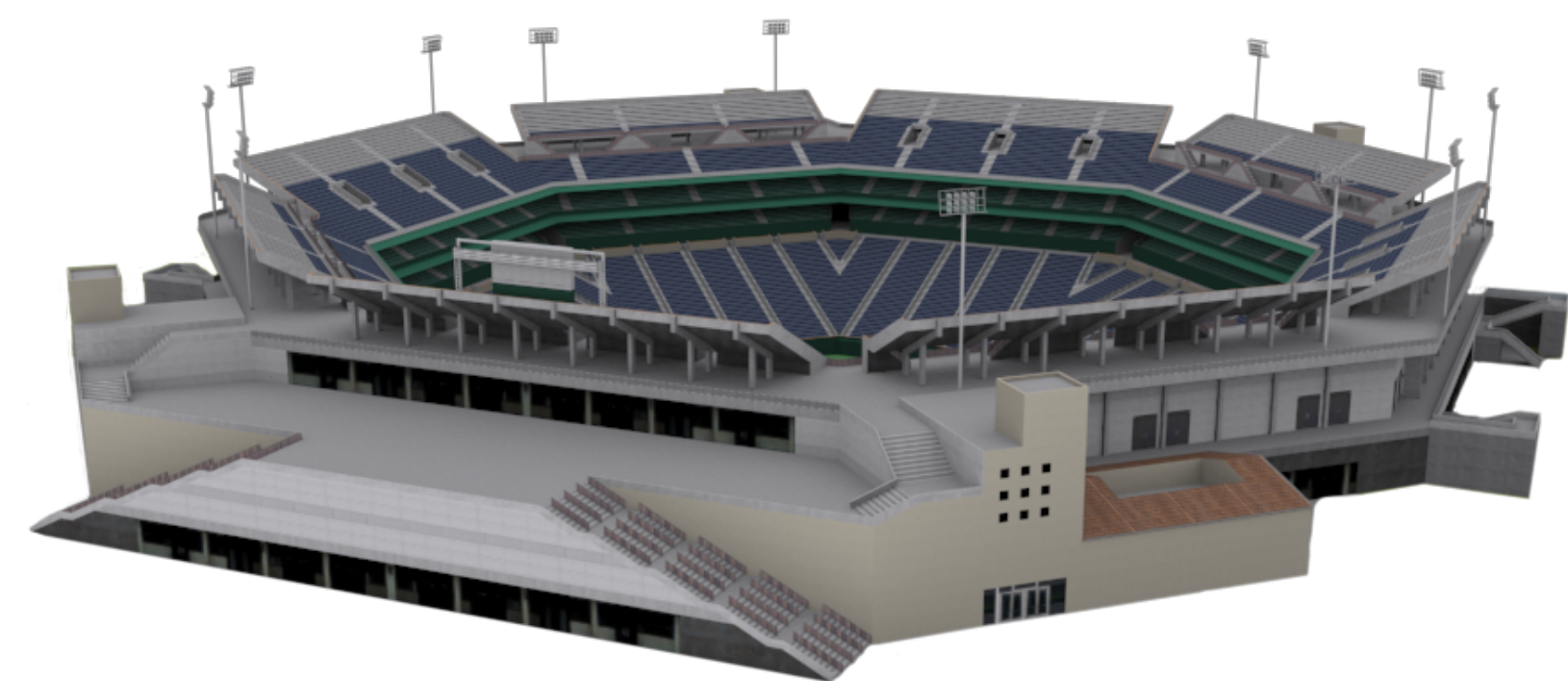

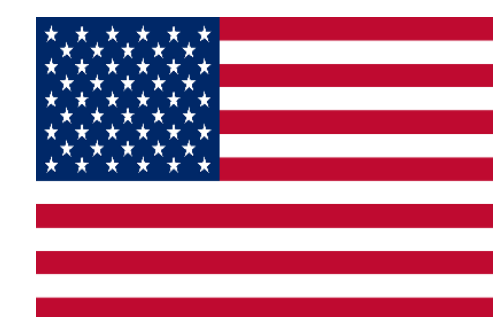
INDIAN WELLS

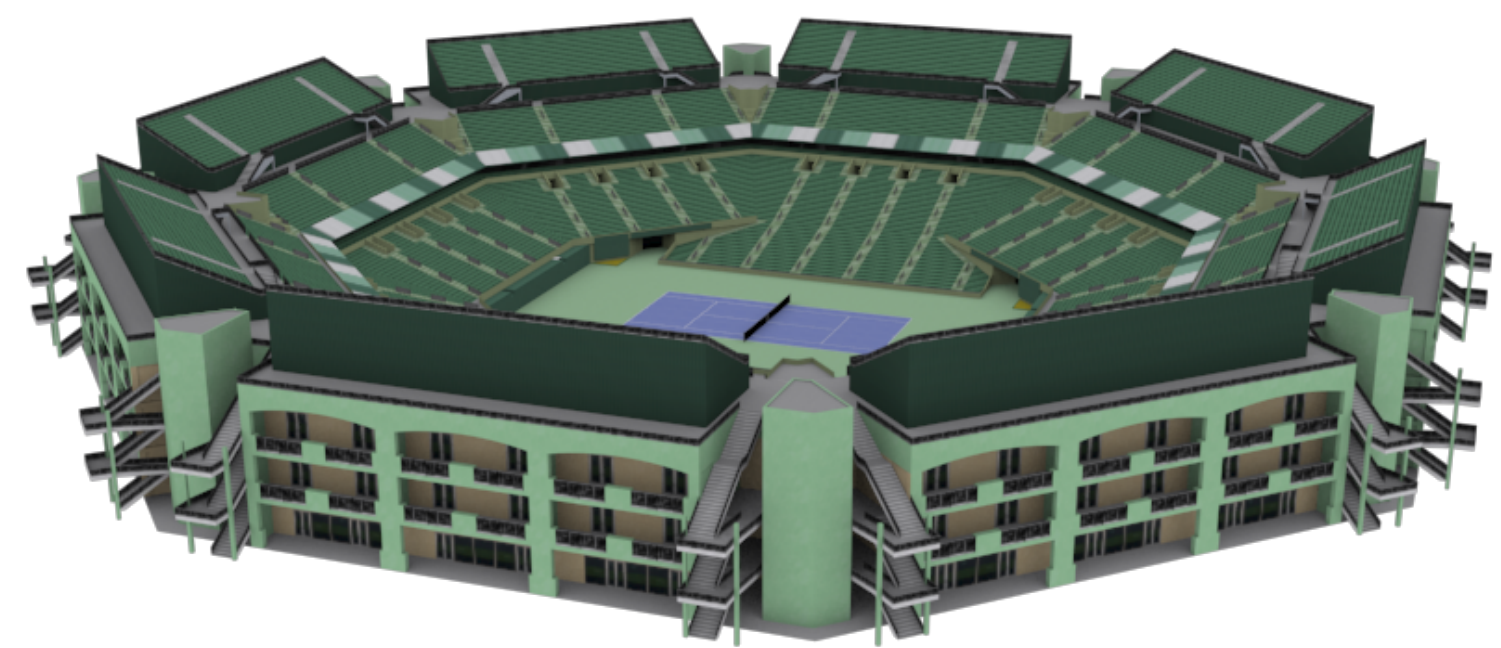

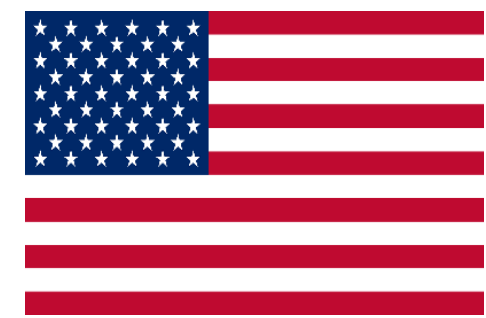
MIAMI

# TENNIS STADIUMS - UNITED STATES

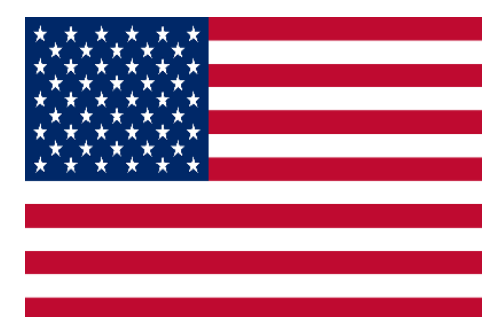
NEW YORK

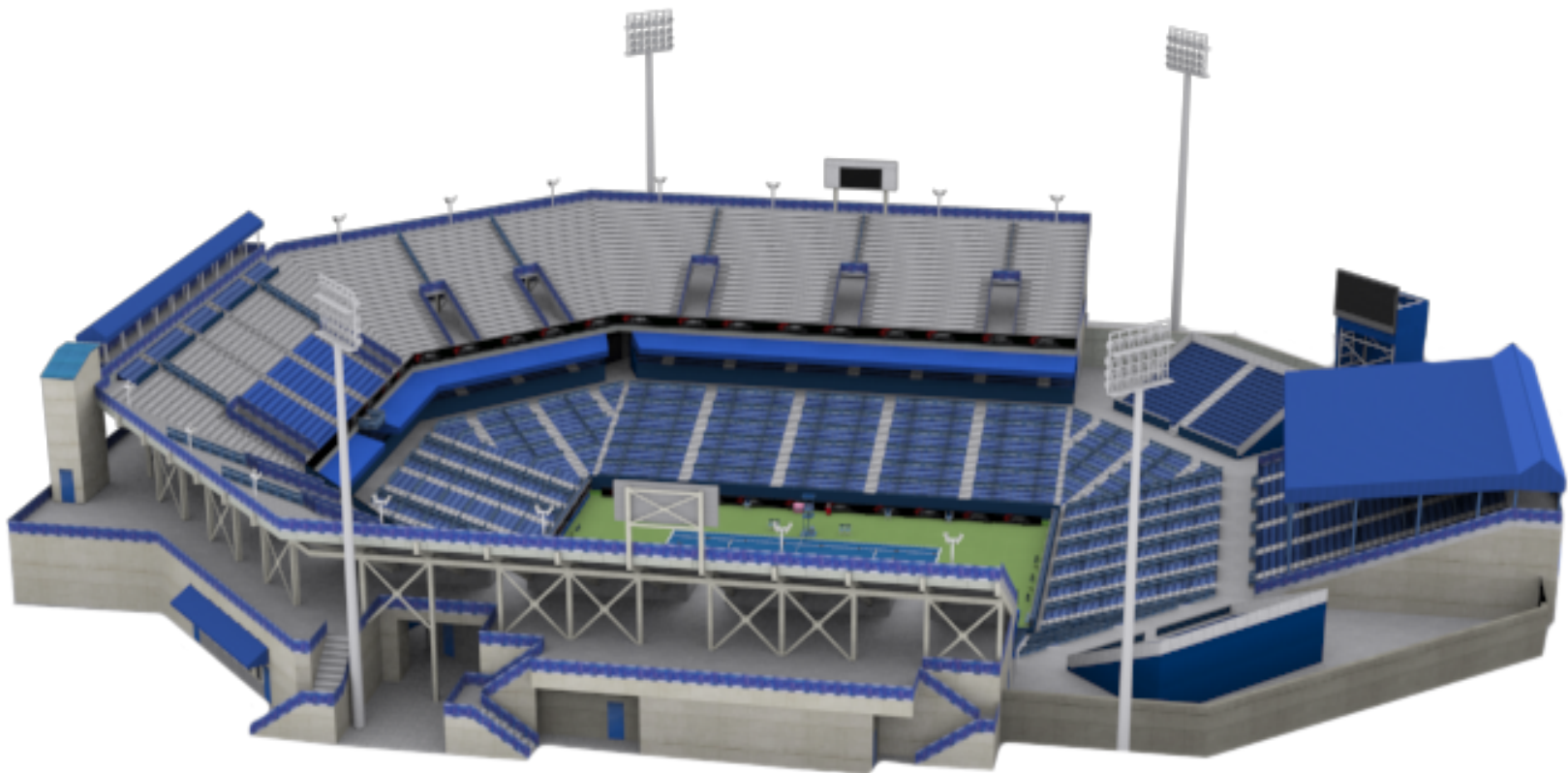

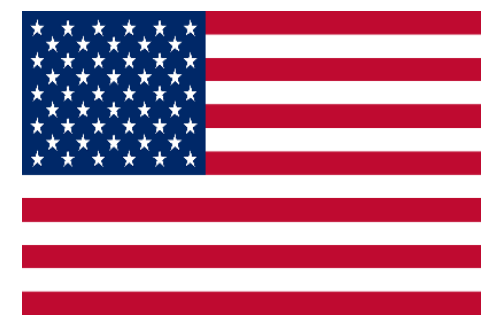
WASHINGTON
