
COURSE TYPE: MOUNTAIN

Renowned for its panoramic beauty in Alberta, is a captivating and challenging layout. The course winds along the Bow River under the snow-capped mountains. It opened in 1928.

COURSE TYPE: WOODLAND

An undulating course set beside a stunning mountain range in Manitoba, Canada. Cut through dense pine forests finding the narrow fairways is paramount, as the greens are well protected by the pine trees and bunkers.

COURSE TYPE: PARKLAND

This course combines large undulating greens and wide fairways with classically styled bold bunkers and ancient woodlands. It gracefully moves over hill and dale though a dense mix of mature trees.
